- Final candidates will be interviewed by the panel with selection complete by March 23,2022.
- The scholarship covers tuition for the 75-hour Home Care Aide training course offered on-line by Cornerstone Healthcare Training, as well as state testing and license fees. Recipients will begin the course in early April, to be completed by the end of June.
